

We do not have Henry Houseman's Service Records. All we have is his Medal Card..

This tells us that he entered the theatre of war in France on the 20 May 1915.

He was in the Royal Field Artillery firstly as a Bombardier and then a Corporal, number 90346 and then as a Lance Bombardier and Gunner, number 1044089.

We know from his Medal Card that he was awarded the British War Medal, the Victory Medal and the 1914 - 1915 Star Medal.

He was also awarded the General Service Medal with Iraq clasp for service in Iraq after WW1.
