

We do not have John Charles Houseman's Service Records. All we have are his discharge papers.

These tell us that he lived at Low Lane, Darley. He entered the army on the 3 March 1916 and was discharged on the 28 March 1919.

He was a private in the Northumberland Fusiliers, but we do not know which battalion, his number was 36118

It would appear from his discharge papers that he was discharged as physically unfit and was awarded a pension due to Gun Shot Wounds to the thigh presumably received whilst in action.

We know from his Medal Roll that he was awarded the British War Medal and Victory Medal so he must have served abroad in the war.
